**Inspection work will close lanes on K-92 Centennial Bridge next week**

A Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) bridge inspection will be conducted on the K-92 Centennial Bridge over the Missouri River in Leavenworth County next week, Tuesday, Oct. 5 through Friday, Oct. 8, weather permitting.

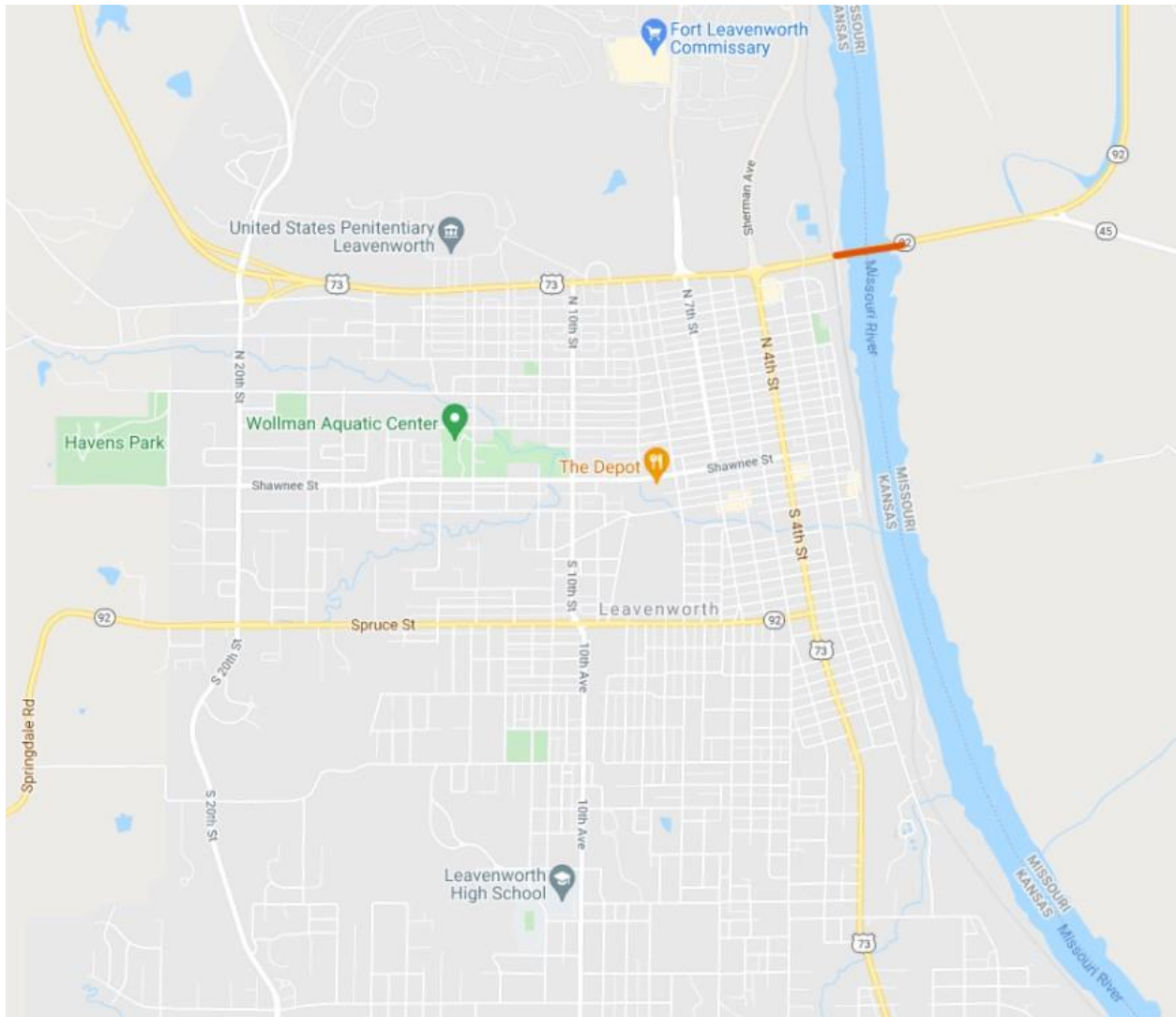
Inspection work will take place from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

During the bridge inspection, eastbound and westbound K-92 traffic will be reduced to one lane, and a flagging operation will direct traffic. Motorists should expect delays of up to 15 minutes and add time to their travel schedule or choose an alternate route.

Traffic will also be controlled using digital message boards, signage and traffic cones.
