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K-32/4th Street survey will begin next week in Wyandotte County

A Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) field survey will begin Monday, Jan. 16, at the K-32/4th Street intersection in Wyandotte County.

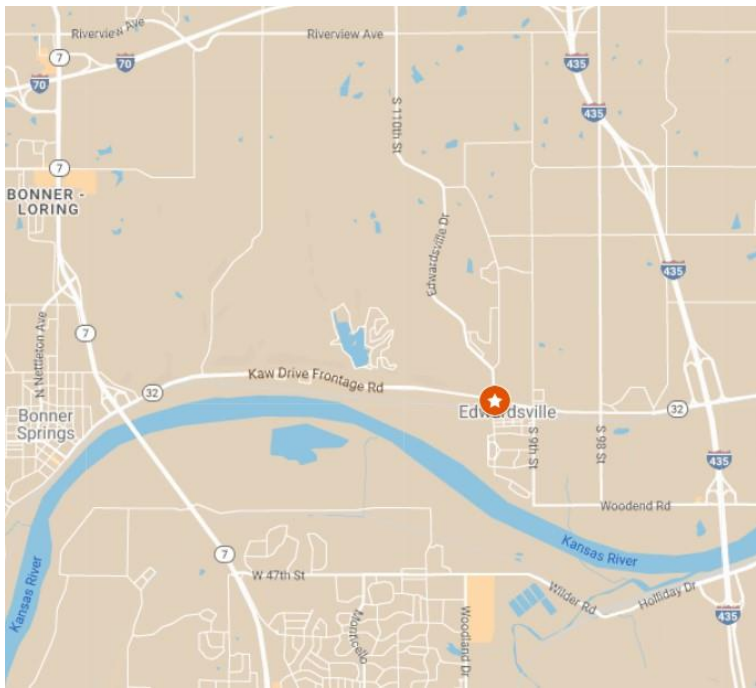
This survey is to gather information necessary for the detailed design of the proposed improvement related to the K-32 bridge replacement over Betts Creek drainage.

The survey area includes approximately 1,000 feet of K-32 and is estimated to be completed by May 2023.

Caleb Rubash, P.S., Survey Project Manager, of Garber Surveying, will manage this survey for KDOT.

A member of the survey crew first will contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.
