I-435/U.S. 69 overnight closures planned for April 28 and 29 in Overland Park

Multiple full closures are scheduled overnight Sunday, April 28 and Monday, April 29 including I-435 lane segments and ramps at the I-435/U.S. 69 interchange in Overland Park, weather permitting.

These temporary closures are necessary to allow for bridge work and are part of the Kansas Department of Transportation U.S. 69 Expansion Project (69Express). Message boards have been placed in the area to alert motorists to the upcoming closures.

The following will be fully closed to traffic from 5 p.m., Sunday, April 28, to 6 a.m., Monday, April 29:

- All westbound I-435 lanes at U.S. 69
- Westbound I-435 to southbound U.S. 69 ramp
- Northbound U.S. 69 to westbound I-435 ramp

The following will be fully closed to traffic from 7 p.m., Monday, April 29, to 6 a.m., Tuesday, April 30:

• Eastbound I-435 to northbound U.S. 69 ramp

During the scheduled closures, the following detours will be marked:

- Westbound I-435 and westbound I-435 to southbound U.S. 69 traffic will be detoured to northbound U.S. 69 and exit at 103rd Street, then turn right and travel westbound to the 103rd Street/southbound U.S. 69 entrance ramp and then to westbound I-435.
- Northbound U.S. 69 to westbound I-435 traffic will be detoured to 103rd Street exit, then turn right and travel westbound to the 103rd Street/southbound U.S. 69 entrance ramp.

• Eastbound I-435 to northbound U.S. 69 will be detoured to College Boulevard exit, then turn left and travel eastbound to the College Boulevard/northbound U.S. 69 entrance ramp.

The 69Express project includes reconstruction of U.S. 69, widening the highway with added express lanes – one in each direction between 151st and 103rd Streets – and interchange improvements at U.S. 69/167th Street in Overland Park.
